

NAME

chi2 – read chi square test statistic and output significance level

SYNOPSIS

chi2 [-**n** *df*] [-**l**] [<] inseq > outseq

DESCRIPTION

For each input pixel containing a χ^2 test statistic *chi2* calculates the corresponding significance level given the number of degrees of freedom, *df*. The number of degrees of freedom can be given via the float extended header parameter *degrees_of_freedom*. If this parameter is absent **-n** is not optional. If it is present, *df* is overwritten if **-n** is specified.

The input must be float, the output is float as well.

OPTIONS

- n** *df* *df* is the number of degrees of freedom
- l** output probability of finding a smaller value of χ^2 rather than the default probability of finding a greater or equal value of χ^2
